


#### Novato Fiesta- Fresher's Day celebration






#### **CONGRATULATIONS**




## **Connected Learning**

#### The Knowledge Center

DVHIMSR Library with vision to support study and teaching houses around 10,000 intellectual works in the area of management and allied subjects in multiple formats including multimedia. Collection comprises of textbooks, reference works, dictionaries, handbooks, case studies, and encyclopaedias for students, faculty and research scholars. Also, it enables access to teaching aids for the faculty use. Library subscribes to recommended journals /serials (print and online) directly from publishers and through subscriptions agencies. Project reports of the students are kept for reference in both the formats. The library functions are automated using "NewGenLib" library management software. Patrons can access the bibliographic information along with available links to digital format of the intellectual works available in the library collection via Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC).
